Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 15 September 2000.
2. The applicants complaint of the non-enforcement of a decision issued by the Commission for Real Property Claims of Displaced Persons and Refugees on 21 March 2000 (decision no. 104 – 2239 - 1/1) confirming their right to regain possession of their apartment.
3. On 7 March 2001 the applicants' representative informed the Chamber in writing that the applicants had repossessed their apartment. The representative suggested that the Chamber strike the application out of its list.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application must be struck out of the list.

**III. CONCLUSION**
