Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(b) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 4 September 2000.

2. The applicant complained of her inability to return to her pre-war apartment located at Ulica Kranjčevićeva 31/l in Sarajevo.

3. The application was transmitted to the respondent Party on 22 June 2001. On 23 July 2001, the respondent Party submitted its observations, stating that the applicant would be reinstated into the apartment in question on 3 July 2001.

4. On 2 October 2001, the applicant informed the Chamber that she had been reinstated into her apartment on 3 July 2001.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

5. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that ... (b) the matter has been resolved; ... provided that such a result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."

6. Considering that the applicant informed the Chamber that she has been reinstated into her apartment, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore decides to strike out the application.

III. CONCLUSION

7. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
