

#### THE SPECIAL COURT FOR SIERRA LEONE (the Special Court),

SITTING AS Justice George Gelaga King, Vice-President of the Special Court, presiding pursuant to the provisions of Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules");

**CONSIDERING** that the Accused is being detained into the custody of the Special Court following the Order for Physiological and Psychiatric Examination and Detention on Remand of the  $15^{th}$  of March, 2003;

**CONSIDERING** that the medical condition of the Accused has deteriorated and now requires urgent medical treatment at a suitable hospital;

**CONSIDERING** the Registrar's urgent oral application pursuant to Rule 64 of the Rules for the transfer of the Accused to the United Nations Hospital in Freetown on the ground of medical emergency;

**CONSIDERING** that the transfer of the Accused to a hospital will require him, as feasible, to be segregated from other patients of the hospital;

**THANKING** the offer of the Deputy Special Representative of the Secretary General for Sierra Leone identifying the United Nations Choithram Hospital in Freetown as a suitable location for the transfer of the Accused;

**NOW THEREFORE**, pursuant to Rule 8, Rule 21 and Rule 64 of the Rules and pursuant to Rule 29 and Rule 32 of the Rules Governing the Detention of Persons Awaiting Trial or Appeal before the Special Court for Sierra Leone or Otherwise Detained on the Authority of the Special Court for Sierra Leone,

**HEREBY ORDERS** the immediate transfer of the Accused to segregated quarters of the United Nations Choithram Hospital in Freetown with a view to provide him with all necessary medical treatment;

**INSTRUCTS AND EMPOWERS** the Registrar to take all the necessary measures for ensuring the medical treatment of the Accused and the necessary security during the period of hospitalization;
