TRIAL CHAMBER II ("Trial Chamber") of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ("Special Court"), composed of Justice Richard Lussick, presiding, Justice Teresa Doherty and Justice Julia Sebutinde;

RECALLING the first and second Status Conferences held on Friday 21 July and Friday 22 September 2006 respectively at the International Criminal Court at The Hague, the Netherlands;

PURSUANT TO Rule 65bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court ("the Rules");

HEREBY CONVENES a Status Conference to be held on Friday, 26 January 2007 at 2.00 pm at the International Criminal Court at The Hague, the Netherlands, in Courtroom 1 before Justice Teresa Doherty;

AND ORDERS

- 1. That the preliminary agenda for the Status Conference shall include the following:
 - An update from the Parties on compliance with disclosure obligations under Rules 66, 67 and 68 of the Rules;
 - (ii) An indication from the Parties as to any points of agreement, including admissions or statements not in dispute and agreed issues;
 - (iii) Preparation for the Pre-Trial Conference pursuant to Rule 73bis of the Rules
 - (iv) Any additional issues that the Parties or Court may wish to raise in relation to the case.
- 2. That the parties submit proposed agenda items, if any, by Friday 19 January 2007.
